The award recipients should be Australian citizens or residents.

The products or processes will feature high achievements in engineering technology.

Each Award consists of the University of Sydney, Faculty of Engineering, Warren Centre medal, and a framed certificate. This will normally go to the individual responsible for driving the innovation to success, but when appropriate will be awarded to a team.
